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USPSA CARRY OPTIC NATIONALS EVENT SCHEDULE

All competitors must have a current CMP Talladega Marksmanship Park Range Safety Card on them to compete in the match. If you do not have a current Range Safety Card you will have to watch the video and complete the CMP Marksmanship Park waiver in the clubhouse before going to the match.

! Registration for the Nationals will be in the CMP Clubhouse.

Competitors need to report to their first stage prior to the start of first shots at 9:00am, but not before coming to the CMP Marksmanship Park clubhouse first to:

- Register for the Match
- Ensure that they have a current CMP Marksmanship Park Range Safety Card
- Complete the USPSA Equipment Survey and Waiver (*This needs to be completed before arrival to the range*).

SIDE MATCHES

There will be two side matches available to participate in. The Side Matches will be in Bay A5 along with the Vendor Area and Demo Bay. The Side Matches are included as a stop in the schedule. See the Squad Schedule for times.

Awards Ceremony and banquet will be held at the International Motorsports Hall Of Fame approximately one hour after last shots fired, prize table by order of finish following awards. Food service starts approximately at 6:30pm.


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USPSA CARRY OPTICS NATIONALS MATCH BRIEFING

THESE POLICIES ARE JUST AS IMPORTANT AS THE RULES. YOU ARE EXPECTED TO READ AND UNDERSTAND ALL THE CONTENTS OF THIS MATCH PUBLICATION.

! All competitors must have a current CMP Talladega Marksmanship Park Range Safety Card on display at all times on the range in order to compete in the match. You will be provided a badge id holder and the card must be visible. This includes all spectators at the range. If you do not have a current Range Safety Card you will have to watch the video and complete the CMP Marksmanship Park waiver in the clubhouse before going to the match. Registration for Carry Optics Nationals will be in the CMP Clubhouse.

Competitors need to report to their first stage prior to the start of first shots at 9:00am, but not before coming to the CMP Marksmanship Park clubhouse first to:

- Register for the Match
- Ensure that they have a current CMP Marksmanship Park Range Safety Card
- Complete the USPSA Equipment Survey and Waiver *(This needs to be completed before arrival to the range)*

COLD RANGE: The CMP Marksmanship Park is a cold range. Firearms will not be handled anywhere on the range except in designated safety areas or under the direct supervision of match staff. Handling firearms in parking areas is unsafe gun handling.

SAFETY AREAS: The range is equipped with a number of safety areas to bag and holster guns, for dry fire practice and gun repair, etc. No ammunition may be handled in any safety area.

PARKING AREA: Competitor parking area is designated on the map. Competitors are not allowed to park across the bridge area or next to the bays.

RULES: The match rules are found in the current edition of the USPSA Competition Rules.

OBEY YOUR ROs: Range officers are here to assist you in completing a safe shooting contest. Please comply with their requests. Please bring any issues to the attention of one of the Range Masters.

SET STEEL AND TAPE TARGETS: Competitors are expected to stay together as a squad to tape, set steel, and help maintain efficiency on each stage.

LOST BRASS: All brass is donated to the staff.

ALCOHOL: Alcohol and recreational drugs may not be consumed anywhere on the range. Competitors violating this policy will be disqualified and asked to leave the range.

DRESS CODE: Practical shooting is a sport. The match director will be the final arbiter of dubious taste.

SCHEDULING: No competitor will compete for score on other than the scheduled dates (6.5.1). Occasionally, stages will clear squads early. If your entire squad is available and the CRO approves, the squad will be allowed to shoot ahead of schedule, but only on the scheduled date.

INSPECTION: When the entire squad is assembled, the written stage briefing will be read. This will be followed by an inspection and question period. Shooters may negotiate obstacles only during this inspection period or while the previous shooter's targets are being scored. Early inspection is permitted by the squad next scheduled to shoot a stage,



providing that the previous squad is finished, you report to the range officer prior to inspection, and time permits.

RANGE OPENING: The range is closed to all competitors prior to the scheduled start time of the staff match Sep. 7th at 9:00am. There cannot be any shots fired until 9:00am. The range will close each day at 6:00pm.

Competitors may inspect the stages when they are available, but may not activate, set, or reset any moving targets or activated props. Competitors are not allowed to inspect the stages until the range has been opened. Competitors must have a current CMP Marksmanship Park Range Safety Card on them before being allowed to go on the range.

HAZARD AREAS: Orange cones and/or safety flagging may be used to restrict certain areas of the range. For safety reasons, competitors and spectators are prohibited from going past these markers without permission.

EYE AND HEARING PROTECTION:

All competitors must wear eye and hearing protection during the course of fire. Eye protection is required to be worn by everyone while on the range. If you do not have adequate eye protection, please see the Range Master.

CHRONOGRAPH:

Competitors will report to the chronograph at the scheduled time for their squads (see squad schedule). If you fail to report to the chronograph for the scheduled test or after a random sampling, your scores will be removed from



the match (App. C2, 42).

- At the chronograph station, do not handle your gun until instructed by the CRO.

- Certified Match Ammunition (App C3) must be declared at registration, the **Certified Ammunition Declaration** completed and turned in with your eight sample rounds. Competitors declaring Certified Match Ammunition will still follow the Chronograph procedures (App. C2)

MATCH SCORING: The championship will use PractiScore. If you have scoring questions, first check your math, then take your score card copy to Stats to remedy the problem.



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USPSA CARRY OPTICS NATIONALS **RANGE FACILITIES**

! All competitors must have a current CMP Talladega Marksmanship Park Range Safety Card on them to compete in the match. If you do not have a current Range Safety Card you will have to watch the video and complete the CMP Marksmanship Park waiver in the clubhouse before going to the match. Registration for Nationals will be in the CMP Clubhouse.

REST ROOMS: Portable toilets are located conveniently around the range.

FOOD SERVICE: Lunch will be available for purchase. Water will be provided on the bays.

CLOSED RANGE: If the range is marked closed, and a barrier is across the range road, no competitors may enter the range for any reason. We will have access to the bathrooms, registration, and ammo pickup available and clearly marked. Any competitor on a closed range will be required to leave and may be subject to disqualification. Please obey the signs.

PARKING: Parking areas will be clearly marked on the range map. Competitors may only park in the competitor areas. Lock your car and take your valuables.

PERSONAL VEHICLES: Unless you have permission from the Match Director or Range Master, you may not take any Privately Owned Vehicles onto the range. If you have a physical disability please contact the MD/RM. The CMP is offering Golf Cart rentals for competitors and are allowed on the range. Carts and wagons are allowed. If you are allowed a POV on the range, you must drive slowly and cautiously, and may not park anywhere but on the side of the range road, leaving clearance for staff vehicles at all times. Parking under the covers is not allowed. Failure to comply will result in vehicle privileges being revoked.

GUN HANDLING IN THE PARKING AREA IS PROHIBITED.

SPECTATORS: Everyone must wear eye protection while on the range and hearing protection is strongly suggested and closed toe shoes are required. Climbing on berms is not allowed. Children must be under the direct supervision of a parent. If you need eye protection, please see a Range Master. All spectators must have a current CMP Talladega

Marksmanship Park Range Safety Card on display at all times on the range in order to compete in the match. You will be provided a badge id holder and the card must be visible.

EXHIBITS/DEMO AREA: The U.S. Nationals Exhibits, featuring many different suppliers to our sport, will be in the sponsor tent at the range. Only sponsors of the U.S. National Championships are allowed display areas on the range. Please acknowledge and thank them for their generous support.

PRIZE TABLE/TROPHIES: Mock Trophies will be presented at the awards ceremony for photography opportunities and personalized trophies and medals will be shipped to recipients after the event. See schedule for times and location. Prizes will also be distributed after the awards ceremony. All prizes are distributed to competitors based on order of finish in each division.

ELIGIBILITY: The National Champion must be a U.S. citizen or a resident with a valid work permit (green card) and a current member of USPSA. Trophies/Plaques will be awarded based on the criteria in Appendix A2 of the current USPSA Competition Rules. In a National Championship, there must be at least 10 competitors in a division, 10 in a class in that division, and 5 in a category in that division for recognition. You must be a current USPSA member before the commencement of the match in order to compete.

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
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USPSA CARRY OPTICS NATIONALS **RANGE DIAGRAM**

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

Anywhere in the shooting area, wrists below belt, handgun loaded and holstered for both strings.


STAGE PROCEDURE:

AMMO SHIPPING

Here's some information for shipping your ammunition to CMP Talladega Marksmanship Park.

NOTE: DO NOT SHIP AMMUNITION BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE! IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO DO SO, AND YOU WILL BE LIABLE FOR ANY LEGAL ISSUES. WE ARE CONSIDERING NOT RECEIVING ANY AMMO SHIPPED THROUGH THE POSTAL SERVICE, AND THEIR CARRIERS MAY DECLINE TO DELIVER IT. YOU MUST SHIP BY COMMERCIAL CARRIER, UPS OR FEDEX OR ANY OTHER CARRIER THAT WILL SHIP AMMO—NOT THE USPS.


1) Use a very sturdy box and lots of tape. Ammo is heavy and the carriers will not treat that box like a carton of eggs. Do not place ammo inside the box loose; use plastic or cardboard boxes with separators designed to hold ammunition. That's usually a requirement for all commercial carriers. Place lots of padding around the ammo boxes. **DO NOT SHIP IT IN AN ENVELOPE.**

2) Put **YOUR** name and "USPSA Carry Optics Nationals" on the outside of the box, in big, **bold** letters, and covered with clear tape. *Put it there in at least 3 different locations.* In addition, insert a business card, or a small piece of paper inside the box with all of your contact information. Some boxes get damaged in shipment, making the outside illegible. The information inside will help determine who the owner is, and allow them to contact you should some of your ammunition be lost due to damaged packaging.

3) UPS/FedEx will ship ammo, ground only, if it's properly marked with an ORM-D Label. Be sure to package your ammo securely in boxes designed to hold ammunition, and use a sturdy box and lots of tape. Most UPS stores and FedEx Office will not accept ammo shipments; you can hand them to a route person, schedule a pickup, or take them to a UPS/FedEx depot/service center.

4) Ship your ammo in time for it to arrive prior to the match. It must go ground, per **UPS** and/or **FedEx** regulations, so give it time to get there. Again: **NO AMMO BY US POSTAL SERVICE.**

The folks at CMP Marksmanship Park will collect your ammunition and store it until USPSA personnel are on the ground at the range. We (USPSA) will distribute it at or around registration or during the match. It will be better if you collect your ammunition during registration periods so that we can assure that we have people on hand to distribute it. You may be required to sign for any ammunition you pick up. If you want to collect your ammo at times other than registration, you may experience a delay in getting it until someone is free.

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
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
