



# USPSA PCC NATIONALS **MATCH BRIEFING**

**SAFETY:** USPSA rules will be followed and we operate a cold range. Long guns may be transferred safely from automobiles to carts as needed. Chamber flags are required and must be inserted prior to shooting and between stages.

**RULES:** We will be following the current edition of the 2020 USPSA Competition Rules.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: 4-wheeled motorized vehicles are not permitted. 2-wheeled electric vehicles are permitted.

#### **GUN HANDLING**

**SAFE AREAS:** Provided around the range. These are the same as safe areas for a USPSA pistol match. You may handle firearms, dryfire, perform maintenance, pet it, whatever but may not handle ammunition in the safe area.

**CARTS:** Long guns are to be carried vertically (ish) muzzle up or down in a cart (conveyance). If your long guns are carried horizontally (laying on a red wagon for example) they are to be bagged.

Most common practice is muzzle down at 45 degree on a baby jogging stroller, or in a case or scabbard. If one of these or similar you must remove it from the cart within approximately 6 feet of a side berm, and proceed to the stage at your discretion. Same for replacing it. If your PCC is in a rack on a motorized conveyance of some sort, muzzle up, you do not need to be close to a berm to take these actions provided your muzzle stays in the same orientation the whole time. Sweeping someone, even with a flagged PCC, is a DQ.

**COMING TO THE LINE:** In the interest of match flow we want the on deck shooter to be as ready as possible depending on the stage. You MAY bring your gun to the start position without RO direction when you are on deck.

You may bring them to the line, muzzle up or down and wait for the Make Ready command. Example: As they are nearing the end of scoring you can and should be at the starting position with your flagged rifle muzzle up or down awaiting commands. This includes bringing said rifle off of your conveyance without direct supervision or direction. See previous.

**10.5.4.3** – Bottom line, you may not sweep any person with the muzzle of a firearm at anytime for any reason. Loaded, unloaded, flagged, not flagged. Common sense gun handling and also a rule. So again, just don't do it.

Hope this makes it more clear and not more confusing. Read through the rule book and if you have questions or concerns just ask before you act.

#### END GUN HANDLING DISCUSSION

**PARTICIPATION:** Shooter participation in resetting the stage is expected and appreciated.

**SCHEDULE:** Squad schedule is posted in the match book. Competitors must compete for score according to the published match and squad schedule. A competitor may not attempt a stage outside of his or her designated time without approval of the Match Director.

EYE & EAR PROTECTION: All competitors must wear eye and ear protection while shooting. Eye protection is required to be worn by everyone while on the range property.

**DRAWINGS & DIMENSIONS:** Drawings and dimensions of the stage diagrams are approximate and may change prior to the start of the match due to safety, production, or my laziness considerations. Inspect each stage carefully and listen to the stage briefing.

**STAGE INSPECTION:** Competitors may inspect the stages at any time as long as a squad is not currently there competing for score. You may not activate props or moving targets. Basically you may look but don't touch.

**SPONSORS:** Please take some time to thank our sponsors either in person or via email. A little thanks goes a long way. A list of sponsors for this years match may be found in the match book.

**SCORING:** We are using tablet scoring and Practiscore USPSA Hit Factor scoring. Verification sheets will not be posted on paper at the range. You may/must view them via your computer, hotel computer, or smart device. The RO's at the stage will keep a paper back up of every competitor score. I highly suggest you actually look at the review screen at the completion of your stage performance. The RO is instructed to read aloud the time for each competitor. Then the RO will transcribe the review screen on to a paper back up log. Your responsibility is to look at the review screen for accuracy, and then touch "Approve". It is not the RO's responsibility to track you down and they will be instructed not to. You may also record from the paper log at the stage either copy it down on paper or snap a photo with your phone or polaroid.

**PRIZE POLICY:** We are providing plaques for Class and Category based on USPSA published National Match award policy. Prize table will be walked in overall order of finish in Division. Should you win a firearm please follow the instructions on the certificate, they are plainly stated. We will not be transferring firearms at the range, they must ship to an FFL.


**AWARD SCHEDULE:** Awards schedule in the match

# USPSA PCC NATIONALS RANGE FACILITIES

**REST ROOMS:** Portable toilets are located conveniently around the range.

**FOOD SERVICE:** Lunch is provided at scheduled times. Water available all day. No other drink or snack facilities available.

**CLOSED RANGE:** If the range is marked closed, and a barrier is across the range road, no competitors may enter the range for any reason. We will have access to the bathrooms, registration, and ammo pickup available and clearly marked. Any competitor on a closed range will be required to leave and may be subject to disqualification. Please obey the signs.

**PARKING:** Parking areas will be clearly marked. Competitors may only park in the competitor areas. Lock your car and take your valuables.

**PERSONAL VEHICLES:** Unless you have a physical disability, or permission from the Match Director or Range Master, you may not take any motorized vehicles onto the range. Carts and wagons are allowed. Please check with the RM prior to driving your vehicle onto the range. If you are allowed a vehicle on the range, you must drive slowly and cautiously, and may not park anywhere but on the side of the range road, leaving clearance for staff vehicles at all

times. Parking under the covers is not allowed. Failure to comply will result in vehicle privileges being revoked.

**SPECTATORS:** Everyone must wear eye protection while on the range and hearing protection is strongly suggested. Climbing on berms is not allowed. Children must be under the direct supervision of a parent. If you need eye protection, please see a range master.

**EXHIBITS:** The U.S. Nationals Exhibits, featuring many different suppliers to our sport, will be in the sponsor tent at the range. Only sponsors of the U.S. National Championships are allowed display areas on the range. Please acknowledge and thank them for their generous support.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The National Champion must be a U.S. citizen or a resident with a valid work permit (green card) and a current member of USPSA. Trophies/Plaques will be awarded based on the criteria in Appendix A1 of the current USPSA Multigun Rules. In a National Championship, there must be at least 10 competitors in a division and 5 in a category in that division for recognition. You must be a current USPSA member before the commencement of the match on June 18 in order to compete.

The Universal Shooting Academy practical shooting school is located in Frostproof, Florida, USA, less than one hour south of Orlando's world famous Walt Disney world and many other attractions. 


